

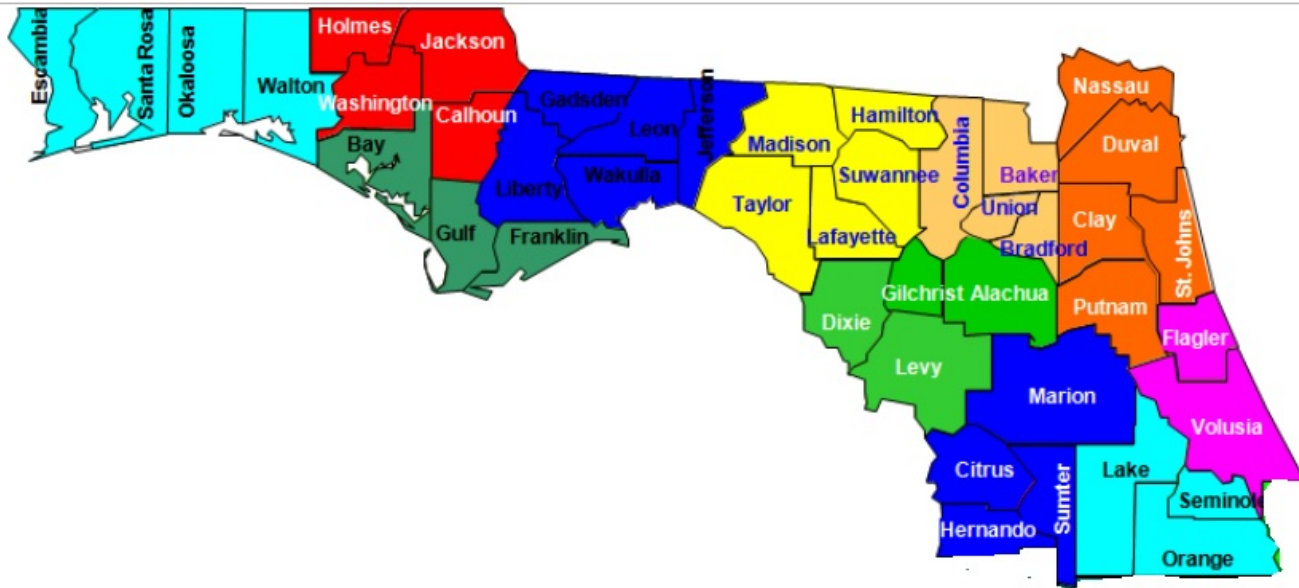

HF Digital Test: Send a text message (ICS-213 if possible) via WINLINK over radio, from your County EOC [or alternate location if unable] addressed to ESF-2 at the State EOC, requesting amateur radio support of your county's EOC to begin on Monday July 29 and lasting until August 2. Three amateur radio operators are needed, and they should have among them: HF, VHF, and digital capability. See Attachment 1, ICS-213 message. Send this message to the address: WA4WES@WINLINK.ORG (Optional: may send by multiple modes, indicate mode)

HF Voice Test: 0800-0830 EDT: 60 m (5.3715 MHz (dial frequency) USB) – Attempt to make contact with the Net Control. 0830-0900 EDT: 40 m (7.242 MHz (dial frequency) LSB) – Attempt to make contact with the Net Control. 0900-1000 EDT: 80m (3.950 MHz (dial frequency) LSB) - NFL ARES net. When possible, during any of these net check-ins, send a voice message from your County EOC to the State EOC: Request one 50 amp power supply; you may utilize the ICS-213 enclosed as Attachment 2. No matter which format you choose, please include some form of "header" that follows this format: Message number, station of origin, place of origin, time filed, date (month, day, year)
