The last operator that deployed for Michael has arrived safely back home. The SARNET closed down today, and the North Florida Emergency Net closed on October 20th at 1900 ET. As of this morning, we are in Stand Down Level. We started at Level III on October 8th. For the last two weeks the NFL Section has been operating in some way for this disaster.

I am gathering information from all that participated. At this time we have over 40 volunteers that operated. This is not counting the people deployed though ARC (American Red Cross), The Salvation Army and the many religious organizations that had there own ham operators.
